Report of the Sixth Transnational meeting

Due to the health emergency caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, the 6th Meeting planned in Barcelona was held remotely in webinar mode on 12 March 2020. The following Partners participated:

During the meeting the following topics were discussed which were already included in the meeting programme:

Innovation Day (Toulon 2020), to be organised possibly even only in virtual mode on the network;

Blue ROV project, verification of activities carried out by 12 March 2020)

Student exchange planned in Toulon, if health conditions improve (logistics, accommodation...)

Communication and dissemination of the latest project activities with particular attention to the possibility of holding the Innovation day and the ROV construction competition in virtual mode on the network.

Output to be produced (also related to ROV construction activity)

Output 1: Training Projects

Output 2: Skill evaluation sheets before the beginning of the training activities (Professors) + Skills evaluation sheets after the training activities (Professors) + Students' self-assessment sheets before the training activities

Output 3: Students' evaluation of the experience (ROV Construction)

Another problem tackled was that of the documentation to be included among the project results, with particular reference to what was foreseen in the Outputs; therefore it was recommended to all partners to carry out complete revisions of the documents produced, both those already compiled by the students and by the staff involved, and those to be inserted as an editable format available to anyone on the network and in particular on the Erasmus + results platform and to send them as soon as possible, in a definitive form, by e-mail to Dr. Anna Mori, including also the documents relating to the activities carried out:

Training pacts, training projects, agreements with companies, evaluation sheets, teaching records, teaching materials, press releases, notices for the selection of students, as well as time sheets of the project team.

Lastly, Dr. Mori (representing the DLTM lead partner) represents the need to increase the days of activity of some partners who have already carried out more days of work than those foreseen, using the possibility of making deviations from some items of expenditure not yet committed.

Hoping for a quick solution to the pandemic, it is confirmed that the next transnational meeting will take place in Toulon in June, in conjunction with the Innovation Day and the students' exchange; obviously it is recommended to keep an eye on e-mails in order to allow all partners to complete the project in the best possible way.
